- Fred DiMaria reported on the current financial status. A check has been sent to the Gun Club and to the farmer for the Wallkill field.
- Warren reported that at the moment, membership renewals are approximately 4 short from last year.
- Redwing field report: Field is in good shape. Field is dry, but the parking hill is too wet to drive on. Use caution when parking.
- Wallkill field report: The field at the moment is too saturated to be able to drive to the parking area when the flying season starts. We will monitor conditions for improvements.
- Jim Cillo and Denis Sardo said that they will set up the stations and fencing during the week when the field opens. Denis has new fencing material.
- The Scale Seminar was held on March 23rd. There was a good turnout of about 30 people. Interesting topics, and a lot of good information.
