- Flavio Ambrosini read the treasury report that was prepared by Fred DiMaria.
- Wallkill field report: The roller was delivered yesterday. Peter Jagich and Rick Rizza rolled the field several times. The ground handled the rolling quite well. It was suggested that the snow fence line be moved toward the runway by approximately 10 feet to provide more room in the parking lot to handle trailer movements.
- Redwing field report: The field is in good shape, but the grass has not been cut. Rob Schultze mowed a small strip for takeoff and landings in the meantime. We will need to look into the mowing situation at Redwing now that the soccer people are not using the field as much.
- Flavio mentioned that the Float Fly at Lake Taghkanic is scheduled for next Saturday as long as there are no issues in obtaining the necessary insurance certificate. Planning on starting at 8:00 AM.
- Charlie Zgnodek mentioned that he has a length of fabric material that he would like to test on the runway for small model use. It would be rolled back up at the end of the day and stored locally on the field when not in use. All agreed to give it a try and see how it works.
- Warren showed off a battery discharging unit that he picked up. Made by "ISDT". Works very well.
