- The minutes from the previous meeting, located on the club's website, were accepted as posted.

- Bob Shilkunas discussed a new possible field that the club board is looking into. It is a field in the Town of Poughkeepsie that is used by the Police K-9 unit for training. Bob and Rob Schulze are drafting a letter of intent to send to the Town.
- Fred DiMaria reported on the club's financial status.
- Probationary members Danny Mittleman and Dennis Sardo were voting in as Regular members by all those present.
- Frank Pagniello mentioned about the Scalemasters over at the Black Dirt field.
