- The minutes from the previous meeting, located on the club's website, were accepted as posted.
- Peter Jagich read the treasury status prepared by Fred DiMaria.
- Peter reminded members that when submitting your membership renewals, to remember to include a copy of your AMA card and to include a self addressed return envelope.
- Rob Schulze reported that there was nothing to report on the Redwing Field.
- Ron Revelle mentioned that the Wallkill Field needs new red fencing material, and new mounts for the fencing.
- It was reported that the "Frost Fly" held at the Redwing Field went well. Eight members showed up and several flights had. The biggest problem encountered was the diminished performances of the Lipo batteries due to the cold air.
- Ron Revelle presented the AMA "Gold Leader Club" plaque to Peter Jachich. There is a need for someone in the club to take over the duties of working on keeping the club's status current each year.
- Rick Rizza brought in his GWS B-2 Bomber. It is powered by two electric ducted fans, and has a steerable nose wheel. Rick added homemade tire treads to the wheels to help improve ground handling.
- Charles Knight brought in his 1/4 scale PT-17 Stearman again to show progress that has been made since the last meeting. It is from Ziroli plans, and is powered by a Torqpro TP70 gas engine (4 stroke, 70cc). He mentioned that it will probably come in around 31 pounds.
- Bill Bernart brought in a 3DHobbyShop Extra 3DLT. It made with a foam hybrid construction, using 2600 amp 3 cell power source.
- Larry Mesic showed his homemade transmitter tray that Charlie Knight made for him.
