Present: 23 members

- Whitney Philbrick discussed his efforts in rebuilding a quarter scale cub that was purchased at the Jamboree. Covering was completely removed, new radio gear setup, working landing gear struts, power with a Zenoah G-20EI. Discussed concerns when dealing with larger models.

- There was a question regarding possibility of a “float-fly” at Lake Taghkanic later this year. Warren will send out an email to see if there is enough interest amongst the club members.
